


Accessing GHA Public Wi-Fi

The following are instructions on how to connect to the GHA Public Wi-Fi, also known as the guest wireless. This is the wireless network that patients and staff can connect to.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Go to Settings/Connections and then WI-Fi
2. Search for: GHA Public Wi-Fi
3. Wait for the web portal to load (alternatively, if no web portal appears then open your browser and go to any website such as google.com and you will be redirected to the portal).
4. Once the portal has appeared, you will be presented with the following screen:
